ONLINE CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

Eligibility:

- The program must be an online program offered by Mendoza College of Business through Bisk.
- The participant must be full time staff within the Mendoza College of Business, with industry skills, work experience, and development interests as outlined in each program description.

Pricing and Financial Commitment:

NON-DEGREE OPEN ENROLLMENT

Eligibility:

- The program must be a non-degree certificate or program offered by the Stayer Center for Executive Education.
- The participant must be full time staff within the Mendoza College of Business, with industry skills, work experience, and development interests as outlined in each program description.
- One staff member is eligible per open enrollment program on a first-come, first enrolled basis as capacity in the program allows.

Pricing and Financial Commitment:

- The College will financially fund 50% of the standard program rate, and the departmental unit may fund the remaining 50% taking into consideration employee development conversations, workplace coverage and budgetary capacity.

- A FOAPAL transfer can be used for payment of program fee. It is the responsibility of the department to initiate the FOAPAL transfer.
